Who belongs and on what basis?



V20: Then Jesus <u>entered a house</u>, and again a crowd gathered, so that he and his disciples were not even able to eat.

V21 – Focus on the family

V22-30 – The religious leaders

V31-35 – Focus on the family

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V21: And when his family heard it, they went out to **seize him**... (ESV)


V21: When his family heard about this, they went to take charge of him, for they said, "He is out of his mind."

V31-32: Then Jesus' mother and brothers arrived. Standing <u>outside</u>, they sent someone in to call him. ³² A crowd was sitting around him, and they told him, "Your mother and brothers are <u>outside</u> looking for you."

V33: "Who are my mother and my brothers?"



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Acts 2v44-45: All the believers were together and had <u>everything in</u> common. ⁴⁵ They sold property and possessions to give to anyone who had need.

Acts 4v32: All the believers were <u>one in</u> heart and mind. No one claimed that any of their possessions was their own, but they shared everything they had.



1 John 3v1: See what great love the Father has lavished on us, that we should be called children of God! And that is what we are!

V22: And the teachers of the law who came down from Jerusalem said, "He is possessed by Beelzebul! By the prince of demons he is driving out demons."

V23: So Jesus called them over to him and began to speak to them in parables: "How can Satan drive out Satan?

V27: In fact, no one can enter a strong man's house without first tying him up. Then he can plunder the strong man's house.

Colossians 1v13-14: For he has <u>rescued us</u> from the dominion of darkness and brought us into the kingdom of the Son he loves, ¹⁴ in whom we have redemption, the forgiveness of sins.

V28-30: Truly I tell you, people can be forgiven all their sins and every slander they utter, ²⁹ but whoever blasphemes against the Holy Spirit will never be forgiven; they are guilty of an eternal sin." ³⁰ He said this because they were saying, "He has an impure spirit."
