V31-32: Then Jesus' mother and brothers arrived. Standing outside, they sent someone in to call him. ³² A crowd was sitting around him, and they told him, "Your mother and brothers are outside looking for you."

V34-35: Then he looked at those seated in a circle around him and said, "Here are my mother and my brothers. ³⁵ Whoever does God's will is my brother and sister and mother."

1) Jesus' Own Family

Acts 2v44-45: All the believers were together and had everything in common.⁴⁵ They sold property and possessions to give to anyone who had need.



1) Jesus' Own Family

Acts 4v32: All the believers were one in heart and mind. No one claimed that any of their possessions was their own, but they shared everything they had.

1 John 3v1: See what great love the Father has lavished on us, that we should be called children of God! And that is what we are!

2) The Religious Leaders

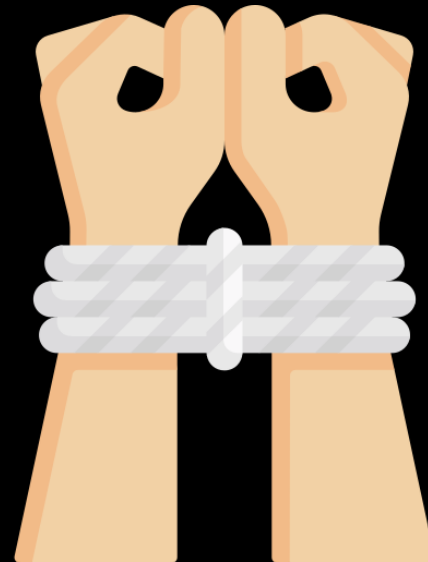
V22: And the teachers of the law who came down from Jerusalem said, “He is possessed by Beelzebul! By the prince of demons he is driving out demons.”
