Read Hebrews 12v1-3. Focus on v3 and discuss the author's reason for writing...

Why then does the author spend the majority of his time **comparing Jesus** with... Angels (Ch 1-2) / Moses (Ch 3-4) / Priests (Ch 5-7) / Sacrifices (Ch 8-10)

1) JESUS – THE FULL REVELATION OF GOD
