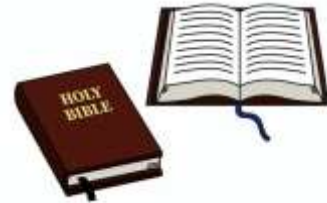




LISTEN UP!

Hebrews 9:1 – 10:18 – “A better sacrifice”

STEP 1 – Find the book of **Hebrews** in your Bibles ...



STEP 2 – Follow in the Bible and **listen up!** (today, we’ll only be reading out a shortened version)

The “Old Covenant” (sometimes just called “Law”) is about how God saves people in the “Old Testament” times – the first section in our Bibles. So the “New Covenant” is about how God saves people nowadays, now that Jesus has come.

and will F _ _ _ _ _ us our sins and purify us from A _ _ _ unrighteousness.

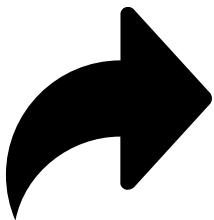
